

Dear School Leader,

The New York State Education Department (NYSED) is reaching out to non-public schools eligible for services or assistance under the federally funded Emergency Assistance to Nonpublic Schools (EANS 1) program. EANS 1 was authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSA Act). We wish to determine if such schools have unmet needs resulting from COVID-19 that could be addressed with additional EANS 1 funded allowable services or assistance.

After all unmet needs are met, remaining unobligated EANS 1 funds will revert to the Governor for allowable uses under the CRRSA Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER II) program. In a proposed revision to the EANS reappropriation language in the 2022-23 Executive Budget, the Governor signaled her intent to make unobligated EANS 1 funds that revert to GEER available to reimburse non-public schools for allowable costs related to preventing, preparing for, and responding to the COVID-19 public health emergency, subject to all applicable federal reporting and accountability requirements.

Accordingly, NYSED is asking each eligible non-public school to identify remaining unmet needs that are **in addition** to any previous requests, submitted applications or allotments within originally assigned allocations. All previous requirements pertaining to eligibility to participate in EANS 1, including certification that the school did not apply for or accept Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) after December 27, 2020, remain in effect. Schools that have previously submitted budgets for EANS 1 **should not** include needs that have already been submitted to be met under their originally designated allocation. The requests you make here should be for NEW funds or assistance.

All requests must be within the guidelines of and allowable under EANS 1. Eligible reimbursement requests and services include:
